1. * Final approval by the Building Official is required prior to use or occupancy.

- * Work shall not proceed until the inspector has approved the stages of construction.
- * Surface storm water shall be diverted from the building site and shall not drain onto adjacent properties.
- * I hereby acknowledge that I have read this Permit/Application, that the information given is correct; that I am the owner or the duly authorized agent of the owner; that plans submitted herewith are in compliance with all applicable city, county and state laws and that all construction will proceed in accordance with said laws. - ** OCCUPANCY WILL NOT BE GRANTED UNTIL CIVIL PLANS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SIDEWALK EXTENSION ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 13TH AVE SE HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE CITY FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL **
- * Any addition/expansion to the foot print of the building including decks and porches not originally shown on the approved set of plans must obtain proper permits prior to construction.
- * Any code requirement that may have been overlooked in this plan review does not imply that the requirements have been waived.
- 4. Effective January 1, 2013 RCW 19.122 Before conducting any construction or excavation within 100 feet of a right-of-way or utility easement containing a transmission pipeline a person must notify the pipeline companies of the scheduled excavation through the one-number locator service 811. Notification must occur in a window of not less than 2 business days but not more than 10 business days before beginning the excavation. If a transmission pipeline company is notified that excavation work will occur near a pipeline, a representative of the company must consult with the excavator on-site prior to excavation.

Permit is valid 180 days from date of issuance. Permit validity is subject to all adhering to all applicable codes, ordinances and standards, and conditions of this permit.
