TRAFFIC CONTROL NOTES

- All traffic control applications and devices are to be pursuant to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), current edition.
- All traffic control signs are to be 36" x 36" with orange background and black lettering (30" x 30" okay on streets classified as "Local").
- The City of Puyallup reserves the right to adjust approved traffic control plans as needed during the project.
- Sign spacing shall be 100 feet when speed limit is 30mph or less.
- A minimum of 11' lanes shall be maintained during entirety of work.
- Type III barricade to be used as temporary traffic control device during temporary gate installation. Barricade will be removed once temporary gates are installed and inspected by the City.

WORK HOURS

- Work shall occur during the hours of 9am to 3pm, unless otherwise approved.

CLOSED

Road Closed Sign, R11-2

CLOSURE ALLOWED for a one-year pilot period as specified under PLCUP20230109 & PRROW20241104 permit conditions.

Call communications center at 253-287-4456 on day of closure. Request a job start inspection through the CityView portal. Public notification shall comply with PMC Chapter 11.05.110. The City-issued permit packet shall be posted at the job site and available to inspectors at all times.

In accordance with MUTCD, signage for extended duration traffic control are required to be post mounted.

All vehicles, equipment, and personnel are prohibited at all times from occupying any portion of the railroad crossing. Railroad crossing signs and striping shall be visible at all times. Vehicle and pedestrian traffic shall not be queued on the railroad crossing.

The Puyallup School District shall provide a detailed notification plan for residents that will be impacted by the temporary closure.

As granted by conditional use permit PLCUP20230109, the temporary road closure shall be reevaluated at the end of a 1-year pilot period. The pilot period shall be measured as one school year and not a calendar year. Regardless of the expiration date printed on permit PRROW20241104 the 1-year pilot period shall end one year from the permit issuance date or at the completion of the current school year.

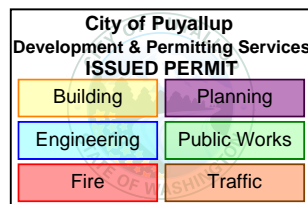
