- Provide all required backflow prevention devices that are required the 2021 Washington State Plumbing Code and Washington State Department of Health to prevent cross connections. This should include Beverage Dispensers, Dishwashers, Ice Makers, Kitchen Equipment, etc. [CONSTRUCTION PLAN SET; 2025\PRCTI20250697\ConstructionPlanSet Wienerschnitzel South Hill TI Arch Plan PERMIT SUBMITTAL SET 05-27-25 (DO NOT USE NOT PLATTEN).pdf; pg. 12]
- Clarify if the refrigeration system will be replaced and if any piping will be replaced. all components that are being replaces will need to meet the 2021 Washington State Mechanical Code. [CONSTRUCTION PLAN SET; 2025\PRCTI20250697\ConstructionPlanSet Wienerschnitzel South Hill TI Arch Plan PERMIT SUBMITTAL SET 05-27-25 (DO NOT USE NOT PLATTEN).pdf; pg. 15]
- Notate if the engineer will need to review the refrigeration system due to weight of the new system. [CONSTRUCTION PLAN SET; 2025\PRCTI20250697\ConstructionPlanSet Wienerschnitzel South Hill TI Arch Plan PERMIT SUBMITTAL SET 05-27-25 (DO NOT USE NOT PLATTEN).pdf; pg. 15]
- If the roof top unit is being replaced, reflect what if any weight difference there is between the existing and the proposed. Show the location of the the new roof top unit on the plans to show proper clearances. [CONSTRUCTION PLAN SET; 2025\PRCTI20250697\ConstructionPlanSet Wienerschnitzel South Hill TI Arch Plan PERMIT SUBMITTAL SET 05-27-25 (DO NOT USE NOT PLATTEN).pdf; pg. 21]
- Indicate on the plans if existing ducting is staying in place or if the ducting will be modified to accommodate the new layout. [CONSTRUCTION PLAN SET; 2025\PRCTI20250697\ConstructionPlanSet Wienerschnitzel South Hill TI Arch Plan PERMIT SUBMITTAL SET 05-27-25 (DO NOT USE NOT PLATTEN).pdf; pg. 21]

Conditions
