Hi Marina,

Yes, you will need construction drawings for the HVAC replacement. The plans should show the location of the replaced unit and all ductwork, etc. that will be replaced (as applicable). If the unit is an RTU, and only that RTU is being replaced, you can submit a "site plan" in the form of a satellite top-down image of the property with the applicable unit highlighted or otherwise identified. This site plan may be used in lieu of an actual drawing.

Please also provide the manufacturer's specification sheet for the new unit and any available information you have on the existing unit (spec. sheet, label, etc.).
