- Insufficient separation between conduit and existing fire hydrant. A minimum 1' vertical and 2' horizontal clearance required. Adjust bore path accordingly or label separations that are in compliance with City Standard Detail 03.01.03-1 and 03.01.03-2. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Include a note that the existing pedestal removal shall be coordinated directly with private property owner and is not authorized under this franchise utility permit. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Proposed bore path shall not encroach on private property unless a recorded easement is presented for review. Provide easement or adjust bore route. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047 PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Tax parcel 0420218006 property lines/edge of ROW does not jog as depicted. Update basemap to accurately reflect current conditions. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Insufficient separation between conduit and existing fire hydrant. A minimum 1' vertical and 2' horizontal clearance required. Adjust bore path accordingly or label separations that are in compliance with City Standard Detail 03.01.03-1 and 03.01.03-2. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Depict the existing utility pole at this location. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Bore path is depicted behind the fire hydrant while Photo #1 depicts the bore path in front of the hydrant. Update accordingly. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Proposed pedestal and pole locations may need to be adjusted to account for correction in ROW lines. Otherwise, provide a copy of a recorded easement for placement on private property. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]
- Please verify that the proposed pole will not have a new anchor and down guy wire. [SITE PLAN; 2025\PRFUP20251342\JB0002294047\_PRINTS-flattened.pdf; pg. 4]

## **Conditions**
