RE: City of Puyallup SWF Permit Application – Supplemental Document

Dear City Engineer Hunger:

Applicant New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”), submits this supplemental statement to AT&T’s application proposing to replace existing City of Puyallup assets with new unmanned Small Wireless Facilities (SWF).

Pursuant to Puyallup Municipal Code Section 20.59.050, AT&T hereby states:

1. The proposed facilities will comply with all FAA regulations and applicable standards, and all other applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
2. The installation, repair, operation, upgrading, maintenance, and removal of antenna(s) by the wireless communication provider shall be lawful and in compliance with all applicable laws, orders, ordinance, and regulations of federal, state, and local authorities having jurisdiction.
3. Applicant agrees to remove the facility within one year of abandonment.
4. Additional diameter greater than the 25% increase allowed under PMC 20.59.050(7)(e) is needed in order to conceal equipment within the proposed replacement pole. AT&T proposes a concealment element design minimizing the visual obtrusiveness of the wireless communications facility installations by fully concealing the equipment, conduit and connections within a 20” diameter pole.
