The city is reviewing an application for large light pole at 812 N Meridian, permit application PRSMS20210109. The new pole will replace an existing light pole.

The reason for the email is the location of the water main and the excavation pit. Per the applicant: For the pole itself the foundation is 3.5' diameter. I would presume 5'x5'x7' hole would be needed to install the foundation. I believe the watermain is far enough away but I wanted to know if you think any specific conditions should be placed on the installation.

The attached drawing shows the distance between the water and pole, see enhanced plan view. And the restoration area.
