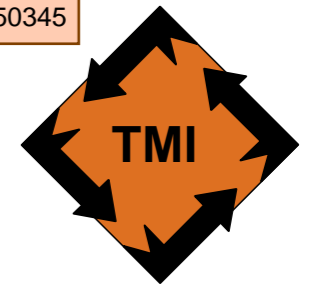

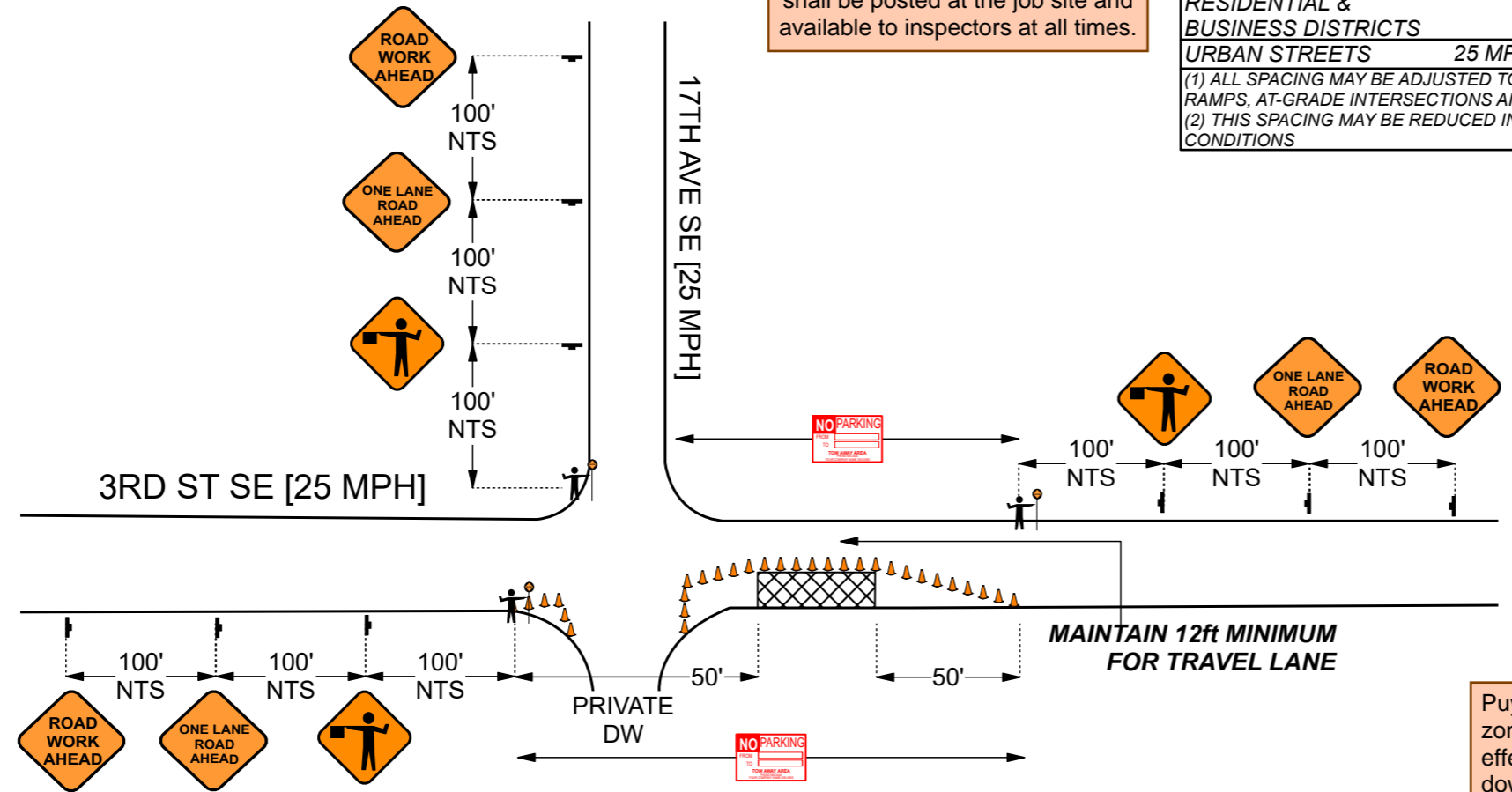

Work shall immediately cease in the work zone for a pedestrian spotter, available at all times, to escort pedestrians around the work area.

Puyallup construction restriction zones and routes shall be in effect during special events in downtown Puyallup or at the Washington State Fair. No work is allowed in the public right-of-way as defined by the Puyallup "Construction Restriction Zone & Routes Map."

The permit holder shall notify MultiCare Good Samaritan Hospital by contacting Aaron Piche, Manager of Engineering Services, at aaron.piche@multicare.org with the proposed impacts and closure hours at least 48 hours in advance of job start. No emergency service vehicle travel routes shall be blocked or rerouted. In a safe manner, flaggers shall prioritize travel for emergency service vehicles.
