Description of Work	<p>Scope of Work: This project involves the installation of a 1/2" Reduced Pressure Backflow Assembly (RPBA) under the counter to serve a new commercial coffee machine. The RPBA will be installed in compliance with local plumbing code requirements for cross-connection control and will be accessible for inspection, testing, and maintenance. The RPBA will be connected to an existing 3/8" angle stop cold water supply using an approved transition fitting to upsize to 1/2". The installation will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installation of the 1/2" Watts LF009QT RPBA with proper clearance. • Installation of an air gap on the RPBA relief vent. • Routing of the air gap discharge (drain) line to the nearest approved drain receptor, such as a floor sink or hub drain. • All work will comply with UPC, as well as local amendments. <p>The installation is limited to the connection of the coffee machine and related components. No other modifications to the plumbing system are included in this scope.</p>
