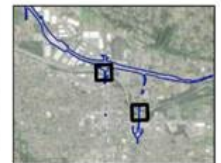
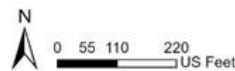
Vicinity Map:

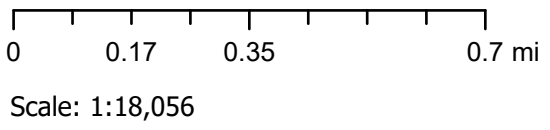
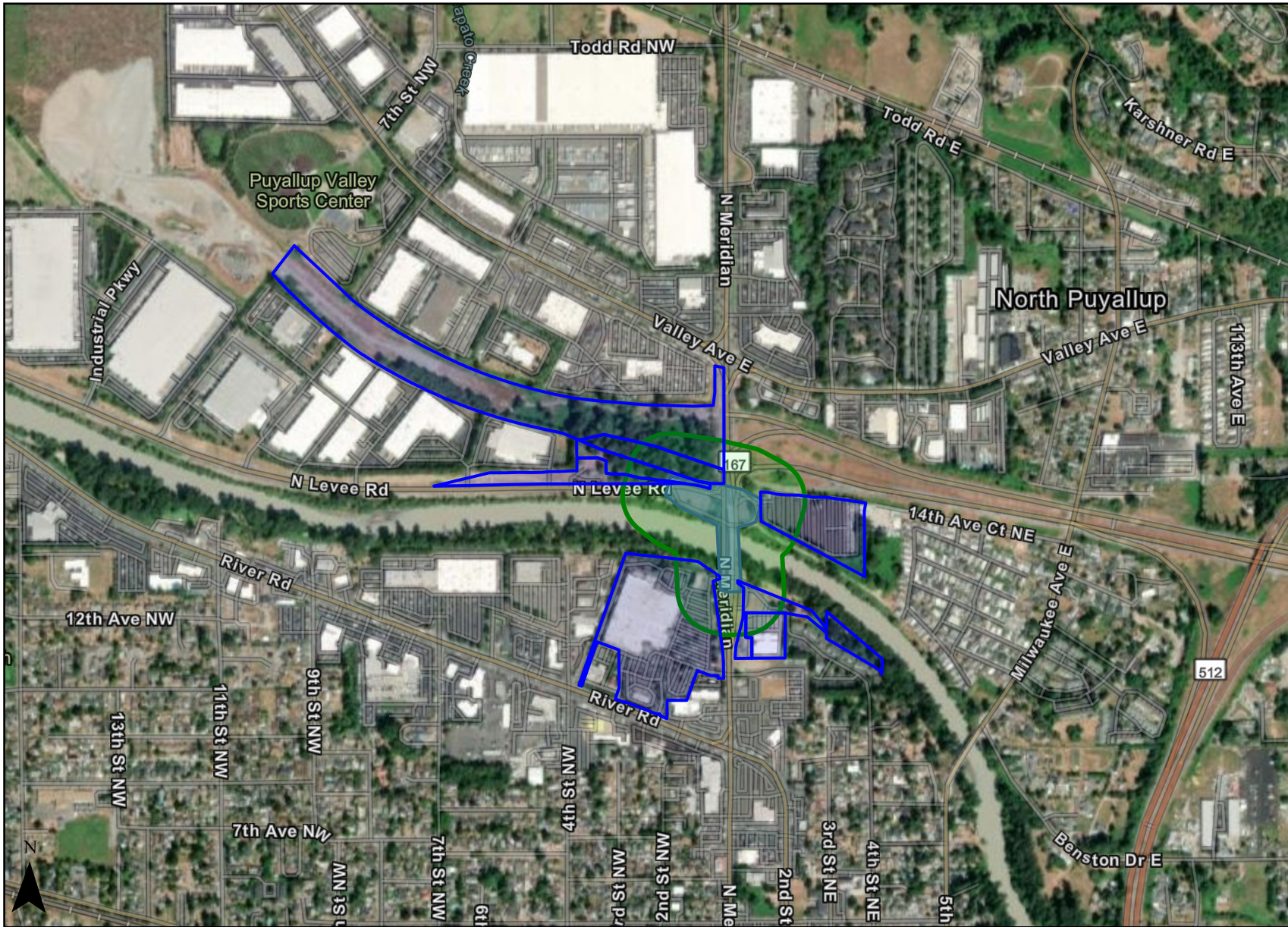
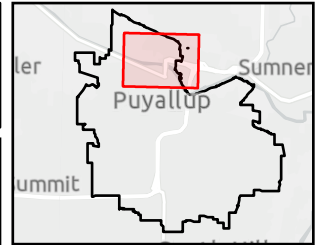

## SR 161 Bridge Mailing Map



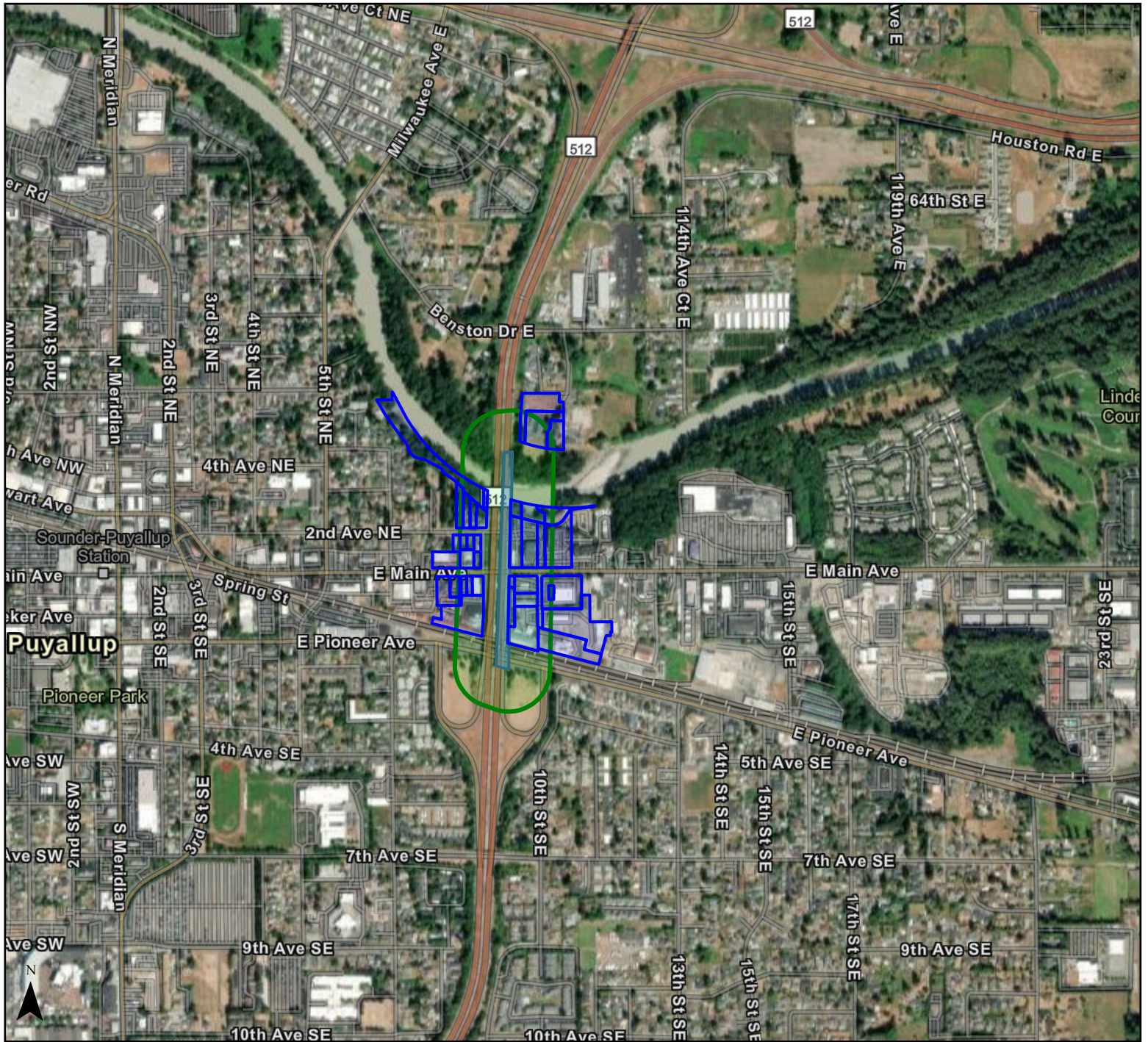

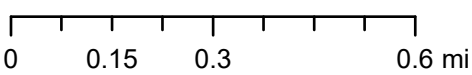
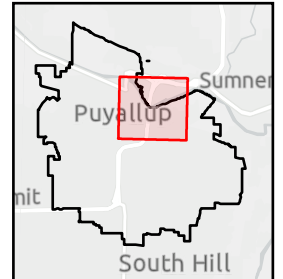
