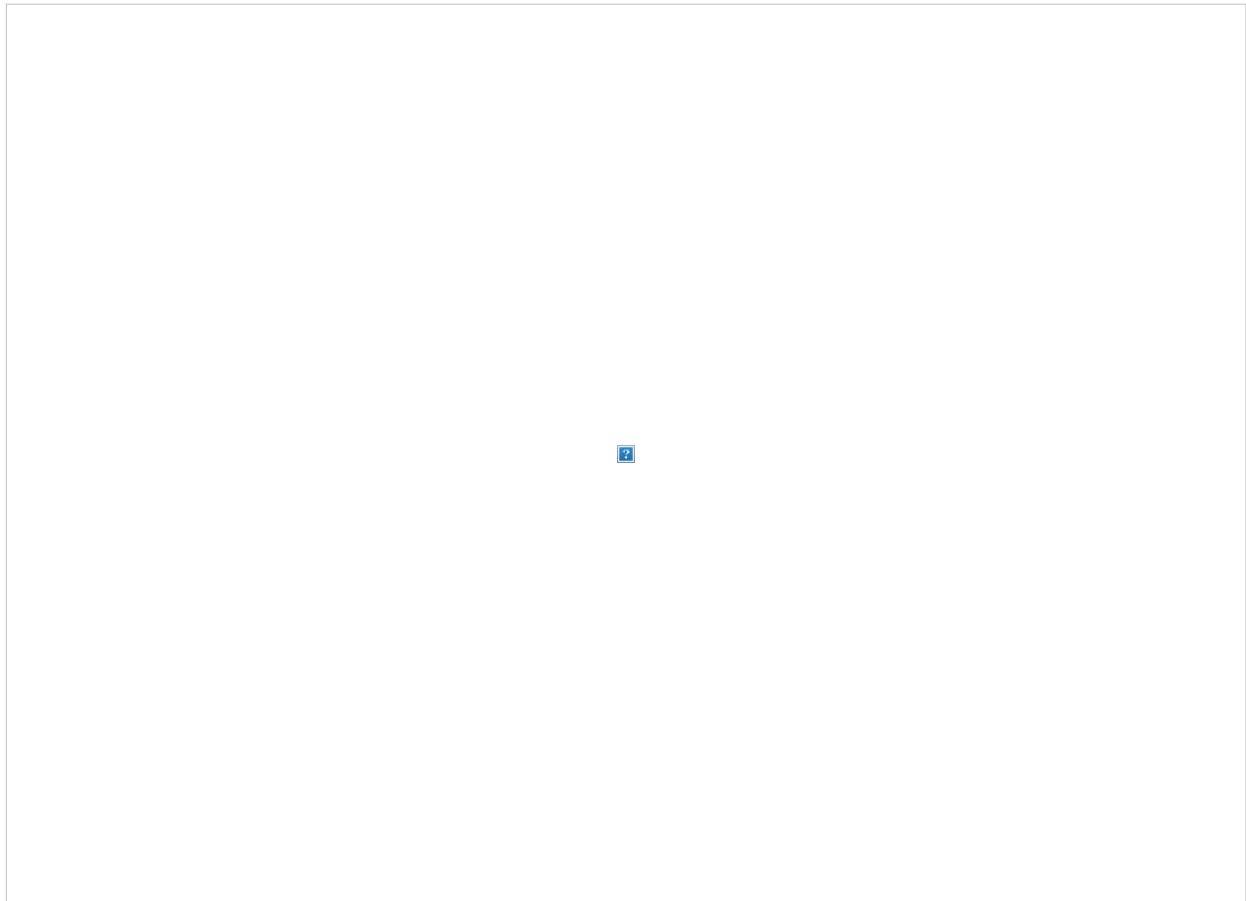
Hi Larissa;

Hi,

My name is Larissa Halos and I live at 3410 20th Ave Ct SE Puyallup WA 98372. There is currently a proposal to build on the corner of Shaw Rd and Crystal Ridge Blvd. Our property backs up to the woods that are slated to be torn down to build more houses. I have positively identified by call and by sight that we have multiple Barred Owls living in the woods. I have also researched that these owls are protected under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act. Being a protected species, an assessment should be started to determine if the property should be cleared and interfere with the wildlife migration or be stopped to allow this species to coexist within our community. My concern is the green belts and nature preserves are being destroyed and these animals have no place to reproduce and live. Please keep me updated on the status of this request.
