Sparks Stadium Parking Lot Expansion Vicinity Meeting Notes CUP #PLCUP20240081

Meeting Information

- Meeting Time: 6:00 PM

Project Overview

- The Sparks Stadium parking lot will be expanded by developing a vacant lot previously used for portable classrooms.
- Parking capacity will increase from 158 to 209 stalls.
- Improvements include pervious pavement, landscaping, lighting, and a widened driveway entrance on 7th Avenue Southwest.
- The project is funded by the 2024 capital levy approved by voters.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in late spring or summer 2025, pending city permitting.

Community Concerns

- Residents expressed concerns about:
 - Driveway blockages due to loading and unloading vehicles.
 - o Increased traffic along 6th Avenue Southwest and the adjacent alleyway.
- Responses from project leaders emphasized:
 - Efforts to minimize traffic disruptions and improve parking flow.
 - Coordination with the Washington State Fair for additional parking in the "red lot" to accommodate large events.
 - The inclusion of landscaped buffers and a gated alleyway connection to reduce neighborhood impact.
