Thank you for your input on this project. As part of the process the City has asked us to reply to your comment in which you expressed concern for potential impacts to wildlife in the area that may result from this project. This project will provide a 100-foot buffer from Upper Deer Creek and a 60-foot buffer from the adjacent wetland in the northeast corner of the project. These buffers will ensure preservation of the onsite portion of the stream corridor in perpetuity. The adjacent property to the east is designated as open space and future development of the properties to the north will require critical area buffers as well. This residential subdivision was sited and designed in accordance with City zoning standards which do allow for this use at this location. Appropriate state and local critical area regulations have been taken into consideration and complied with for this project as well.
