



SPORTS IN BRIEF

Oklahoma QB Williams enters transfer portal

Oklahoma quarterback Caleb Williams said Monday he is entering his name in the transfer portal so he can speak with other schools.

The freshman added he had not ruled out staying with the Sooners, but within hours of Williams' announcement, Oklahoma might have found his replacement.

Former UCF quarterback Dillon Gabriel, who had committed to transfer to UCLA last month, posted on Twitter that he was instead planning to go to Oklahoma.

Williams, a former five-star recruit from Washington, D.C., who was recruited to Oklahoma by then-head coach Lincoln Riley, revealed his intentions on social media.

Riley left Oklahoma to become coach at Southern California the day after the Sooners ended their regular season with a loss to Oklahoma State. Former Clemson defensive coordinator Brent Venables was hired to replace Riley.

Wisconsin: Wisconsin linebacker Leo Chenal is entering the NFL draft rather than returning to the Badgers next season.

Chenal announced his decision Monday on social media. The move comes after Chenal earned second-team honors on the Associated Press All-America team as a junior.

Chenal was the leading tackler for a Wisconsin defense that allowed the fewest yards per game of any Football Bowl Subdivision team this season.

WNBA

Aces hire Hammon: Becky Hammon was ready to lead her own team. So she went back to where her professional career

began - the WNBA. Hammon, an assistant with the San Antonio Spurs, will take over as the Las Vegas Aces' head coach after the NBA season concludes.

"Being the head coach of the Las Vegas Aces is a step forward and a step in the right direction for myself and for women's basketball," Hammon said. "I cannot emphasize enough the importance of this opportunity that I have. There's something to being a head coach."

Hammon has spent eight seasons as a Spurs assistant and has interviewed for several NBA head coaching jobs. But for now, her dream of becoming the first woman to lead an NBA team is on hold.

Baseball

Maybin retires: Outfielder Cameron Maybin is retiring after 15 major league seasons.

"Although my journey as a professional baseball player ends here with the announcement of my retirement, my work in this game is just getting started," Maybin wrote in a statement on Twitter on Monday. "I'm excited for what lies ahead, including my work with the Players Alliance in our effort to provide access and opportunity for the next generation of Black ballplayers."

Vlhova beats Shiffrin: Slovakian skier Petra

Vlhova won a women's World Cup slalom in tough race conditions on Tuesday for her fourth win in five races this season.

Mikaela Shiffrin finished five-tenths of a second behind in second place upon her return to competition following a positive COVID-19 test and missing two races last week.

Shiffrin, who was only cleared to race on Monday, was the only racer to finish within two seconds of Vlhova's winning time. Slalom world champion Katharina Liensberger was 2.11 behind in third.

It was Vlhova's third straight win in the traditional first slalom race of the calendar year, which Shiffrin had won four times between 2013 and 2019.

Soccer

Austin FC, Ring agree: Veteran midfielder and club captain Alex Ring has agreed to a new multiyear contract with Austin FC of the MLS that also makes him one of the club's designated players.

Ring's contract includes guarantees for 2022 and 2023 with options for the following two years, the

club announced Monday. Financial terms were not disclosed.

Ring played in 31 matches in Austin's inaugural 2021 season, with four goals and three assists. The Finland native played the previous four seasons with New York City. He also has 44 career appearances with the Finland national team. Nagamura hired by Dynamo: Paulo Nagamura was hired as coach of Major League Soccer's Houston Dynamo on

Monday. An MLS midfielder from 2005-16, the 38-year-old Brazilian replaces Tab Ramos, who was fired in November.

Nagamura joined Kansas City II's coaching staff as an assistant in 2017 and was head coach of the second-tier team for the past four seasons. His team finished 15th in the 16team Eastern Conference last year with four wins, 20 losses and eight draws.
