**Re: Architectural Narrative**

Dear Mr. Beale,

The architectural narrative for the MultiCare Good Samaritan Hospital Master Plan Proposal is detailed on page 46 of the 2023 document, within the *proposed development* section, beginning on page 41. The narrative describes the anticipated phasing strategy of the 20-year Master plan proposal and articulates how the latest infrastructure will meet the increased demand for patients, staff, and visitors.

Our design team has reviewed the architectural narrative and proposed 3D block conceptual massing study, found on pages 50 and 51, following Figure III-B in the *proposed development* section. The proposed conceptual massing diagrams, in combination with the detailed site plans, further clarify the design concept through the phasing sequencing and fulfill the architectural elevation requirements for the Master Plan proposal.
