Description of the Proposal: The Proponent seeks to develop an expansion of the Good Samaritan Hospital campus, including a new patient care tower [approximately 240,000 square feet, 190 new beds (160 Licensed beds, 30 observation beds)], two (2) new medical office buildings (appx. 200,000 square feet), central support tower (90,000 square feet), expansion of the existing Emergency Department, added building area and infrastructure related to the campus' Central Utility Plant, new off-street parking, including parking garages and surface level parking, utility improvements, street improvements, landscaping, storm water infrastructure and other necessary improvements to support the development.

EIS Required: The City of Puyallup, as the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) lead agency, has determined this proposal may have significant adverse environmental impacts on the environment. An EIS is required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) and will be prepared.

Elements of the Environment: The lead agency has preliminarily identified the following elements of the environment that may be impacted by the project proposal which will be the focus of the discussion and analysis in the EIS.

The Lead Agency is requesting comments on this preliminary list of areas of the environment scoped to be studied in the EIS to assist in defining the final scope of the EIS document.

- 1. Transportation, particularly roadway network, vehicular traffic, traffic safety and parking
- 2. Public Services and Utilities, including sanitary sewer, storm water, domestic water availability, fire services
- 3. Environmental health, including noise, risk of explosion, and hazardous materials
- 4. Air Quality
- 5. Earth, including volcanic, steep slope and erosion hazard areas
- 6. Land and Shoreline Use, including aesthetics, and historic and cultural resources/preservation
- 7. Energy, including availability, amount required/rate of use/efficiency, conservation and renewable resources
- 8. Alternatives
- 9. Mitigation measures

Scoping: Agencies, affected tribes, and members of the public are invited to comment on the scope of the EIS. You may comment, among other matters, on topic areas that should be included in the EIS, request alternatives to be studied, mitigation measures, probable significant adverse impacts, and licenses, permits or other approvals that may be required. Appeals: You may appeal this Determination of Significance (DS) may be filed with the SEPA Responsible Official by applicable parties and agencies within 10 days of expiration of the comment period, or no later than 4pm, Friday, December 30, 2022.
